





Come and walk round the castle and for those who want to look over the top of the battlements. The castle is on Southsea Common and over looks the Solent. We will be enjoying lunch at the Courtyard Café & Restaurant.</p>

The collections in London include some very early aircraft designs through to the latest modern day jets and military aircraft. With over 100 aircraft on site, nowhere else in London enables you to get close to so many historic and ground breaking aircraft.</p> <p>We will be spending time wandering the museum and also eating lunch at the Echo Alpha Tango Restaurant at the Museum.</p>
